Provides legal services with a focus on special needs trusts. A Special Needs Trust is developed to manage resources for a person with a disability (physical or mental) while maintaining the individual's eligibility for public assistance benefits. The family leaves whatever resources it deems appropriate to the trust and the trust is managed by a trustee on behalf of the person with the disability.

Attorneys knowledgeable about Special Needs Trusts and current government benefit programs can guide you on whether to begin the trust now or wait.
