Accommodations are made for visitors with disabilities for a cumulative 21-day period, during a 365-day period beginning with the visitor's first use of service during the 36- day period. Visitors must present documentation that they are eligible to receive ADA paratransit services in the jurisdiction in which they reside. You may contact the Paratransit Coordinator at 703-746-4084 to arrange complementary paratransit service. Trips are provided by taxicabs and wheelchair-accessible vans and operate throughout the Alexandria City, Falls Church City, Arlington County, Fairfax County, and Fairfax City.
