A specialist will check to verify that a Road to Recovery Transportation program is available in that area and will take your information. Call at least four business days in advance so a volunteer driver can be found.

Patients must be traveling to a cancer-related medical appointment. Other eligibility requirements may apply. For example, a caregiver may need to accompany a patient who cannot walk without help or is under age 18. Specific requirements may change per availability in areas.
