There are several reasons for attending a Driver Improvement Program. Learn about the <u>Driver Improvement Program</u> and reasons for attending a Clinic.

When you satisfactorily complete a driver improvement clinic, you'll learn defensive driving techniques that can help you avoid and prevent crashes. These eight-hour classroom sessions cost no more than \$100 and are offered at sites around the state and as an online course on the Internet. If the course is court-directed, contact the court to be sure it will accept a computer-based course. Also, if you are under age 20, you must enroll in a clinic that provides classroom instruction.
